For compact cars

13"-15" – 80 to 55 Series – T (up to 190 km/h / 118 mph)

Network sipe technology:

excellent traction thanks to large numbers of gripping edges

Rubber compound with anti-frost polymers:

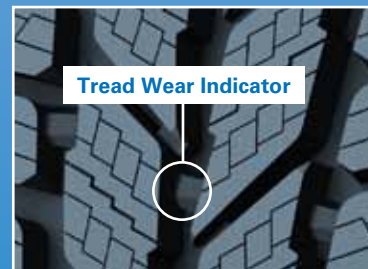
consistently high grip in snow and ice throughout the entire service life of the tyre

Modern tyres not only offer optimum performance whatever the weather – they also come equipped with useful safety features.

The Tread Wear Indicator (TWI)



Safety tip:

Take particular care when checking the tread depth on your tyres, because this determines many of its characteristics. Semperit recommends replacing winter tyres if the tread depth is less than 4 mm*. You can tell the remaining tread depth and the legally specified minimum tread depth by checking the Tread Wear Indicators, which will then be level with the tread surface

* The legally required minimum tread depth is 1.6 mm.

improved traction and lateral guidance in snow

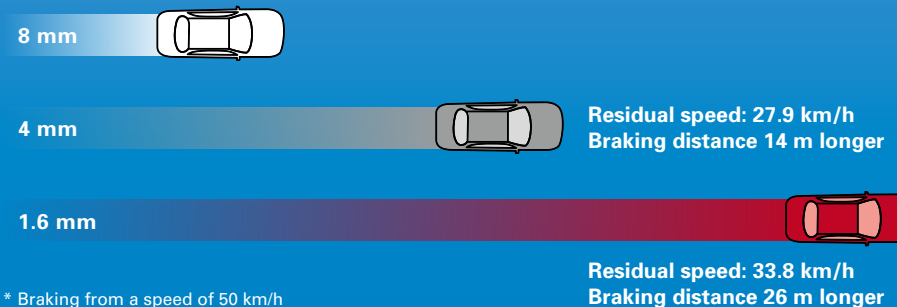
High number of lateral grooves:

Van-Grip – The load-bearer

For MPVs, light vans, minibuses and light trucks

14"-16" – 80 to 60 Series – LI up to 121/120 – Q/R/T (up to 190 km/h / 118 mph)

Three wide circumferential grooves:

high aquaplaning protection

Large number of lateral edges and sipes:

excellent traction in snow and ice

Flat, wide tread contour:

even tyre wear for higher mileage performance

The 'Snowflake on the mountain' symbol



Tyres with special designation:

Modern winter tyres carry the symbol with the mountain and the snowflake alongside the M+S marking. This new symbol indicates that the tyre is particularly suitable for road conditions in winter. It is a true sign of quality and one you can rely on, because only tyres with excellent, proven traction values in snow are allowed to carry it.
